- 2. Performance Shares awarded pursuant to the Exelon Long Term Incentive Plan. 1/3 of the shares awarded vest immediately upon receipt. The remaining shares vest in 1/3 increments on each of the first and second anniversaries of the award date. Under certain circumstances some or all of the vested shares may be settled in cash on a 1 for 1 basis based on the cash value of the underlying stock on the date of vesting.
- 3. Restricted stock units granted on 08/31/2007 under the Issuer's Long Term Incentive Plan and reported on a Form 4 filed on 09/04/2007. Restricted stock units may be settled on a 1 for 1 basis in shares of Exelon common stock, or for the cash value of Exelon common stock on the 4th anniversary of the grant date.
- 4. Phantom shares held in a multi-fund deferred compensation plan to be settled for cash upon the reporting person's termination of employment for any reason on a 1:1 basis. Shares are acquired through regular periodic contributions, company matching contributions, and the automatic reinvestment of dividends.
- 5. Non qualified employee stock options, awarded pursuant to the Exelon Long Term Incentive Plan. Options vest in 1/4 increments on each of the first four anniversaries of the grant date, referenced in column one, and expire on the tenth anniversay of the grant date.
