## **Explanation of Responses:**

- 1. Restricted stock units granted under the Issuer's Long Term Incentive Plan. Restricted stock units may be settled on a 1 for 1 basis in shares of Exelon common stock. 100% of the shares will vest on 08/01/2013.
- 2. Performance Shares awarded pursuant to the Exelon Long Term Incentive Plan. 1/3 of the shares awarded vested immediately upon receipt. The remaining shares vest in 1/3 increments on each of the first and second anniversaries of the grant date. Under certain circumstances some or all of the vested shares may be settled in cash on a 1 for 1 basis based on the cash value of the underlying stock on the date of vesting.
- 3. Non qualified employee stock options, awarded pursuant to the Exelon Long Term Incentive Plan. Options vest in 1/4 increments on each of the first four anniversaries of the grant date, referenced in column one, and expire on the tenth anniversay of the grant date.
